Motions on FPPC and IPC

April 30, 2004

Motion 1: CFG moves that the Financial Policy and Planning Committee (FPPC) be eliminated as of the end of the 2003-4 academic year.

Rationale: FPPC has not functioned well for a number of years. Recently the faculty has shown its unhappiness with the committee by not being willing to serve on it (in 2003 one faculty member expressed willingness to serve; in 2004 none did). CFG believes that the FPPC's functions can be better performed by a strong, broadly representative committee chaired by the President.

Motion 2: CFG moves that the membership of the Institutional Planning Committee (IPC) for the 2004-5 academic year be modified as follows:

Current Membership (Faculty Handbook page 215): The President, the Vice President for Academic Affairs and Dean of the Faculty, the Vice President for Business Affairs, the Vice President for Advancement, Chairs of CEPP, ~~Financial Policy and Planning Committee~~, and a ~~faculty representative from All College Council~~, two additional faculty elected for staggered four-year terms, one of whom is tenured, the other not, ~~two~~ students
